3. The Context :

Covid 19 or the pandemic of Corona Virus has left uncountable wounds and threats in our hearts as well as memories. It was one of the most dangerous disasters in the history of pandemics. 4. The Practice :

They have visited every home with masks, sanitizers and important information about how to control corona virus. Our college students like Ku. Ahilya Vitthal Gore, Ku. Vaishnvi Baburao Bhosale, Ku. Vishakha Bhimrao Barde, Avinash Gautam Thorat and Rameshwar Lalji Dhone have volunteered themselves for this significant task. Girls have stitched Masks on sewing machines by their own hands. They have taken help form the Youtube videos regarding the creation of masks. Then, they have visited door to door in their villages and distributed masks free of cost. At the same time, they have also demonstrated the right way of washing hands with sanitizers and soaps. These students also guided people about how to increase once own resistance power or immunity power to face diseases like fever, flues, cough, etc. People were pleased by the service of these college students. Their will power and confidence to face the pandemic has been raised

surprisingly by the guidance and demonstration by the students especially girl students.
